

NSPA Support Offer

NATO's Integrated Logistics and Services Provider Agency

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The NATO Support Agency (NSPA) brings NATO's logistics and procurement support activities together into a single organization to provide its stakeholders with integrated multinational support solutions across a wide range of capability domains. One of the most effective organizational forms for managing multinational logistics support is the Support Partnership (SP). An SP is established by two or more nations to provide common support for a particular weapon system or type of equipment (e.g. Patriot, Global Positioning System) or for a specific capability domain (e.g. strategic lift, operational logistics support, ground-based defence).

NSPA portfolio of Logistics Support

Central Europe Pipeline System (CEPS) (5 599 km of pipeline)

- Point-to-point transport of diesel, gasoline, domestic fuel and naphtha (approx. 13 million m³ per year)
- Aviation fuel banking system (JET A-1)
- Storage capacity of 1.25 million m³ (33 depots) – several depots with truck-loading stations, 2 depots with rail-loading stations
- Product Quality Control (product analysis at entry and delivery points – internationally certified laboratories)

Airlift Management

- Management and support of three Boeing C-17 Globemaster IIIs operated by the Heavy Airlift Wing (HAW).
- Nations can use those assets in the context of national, NATO, EU and UN commitments.
- Support to participating nations on the basis of pre-agreed allocation of flying hours.

- Land systems
- Aircraft (fixed and rotary wing)
- Naval systems

Logistics services

- Supply management and automation – including e-portal hosting of multiple web-based e-Logistics solutions – and warehousing
- Maintenance, repair and calibration, including sustainment management
- Transportation services (management and provision of air, sea and land transportation – to include rail)
- Host Nation for projects under the NATO Security Investment Programme (NSIP)
- Port services
- Random Brokerage (including one-off procurement of off-the-shelf items to meet special mission requirements)
- Dismantling, demilitarization and destruction (NATO Trust Funds or (multi)national arrangements)
- Project management (turn-key solutions) and technical assistance
- Services to contribute to life-cycle support of assigned systems
- Logistics Data Management (NATO Codification, configuration and documentation management, Product Life Cycle Support (PLCS) data management support)

Crisis Response Operations – including NATO Response Force (NRF) support

- Planning and management of contracting for NATO operations (for Allied Command Operations and nations)
- Integrated Logistics Support for deployed operations
- Real Life Support (RLS) and Airport Of Debarkation (APOD) services
- Multiple services in support of expeditionary operations (including provision of fuel)
- Civil engineering projects
- Disaster relief
